


boiacca lucidi pevere

In 2011, Kristalia accepted the challenge proposed by the designer duo LucidiPevere to develop a cement table. This led to the creation of Boiacca, an award-winning product and a great success with critics and the public. It received a honourable mention at the Compasso d'Oro 2014 Awards. Meanwhile, Kristalia had already embarked on another challenge: to shift from the material quality of cement to the warm appeal of wood, with its Boiacca Wood version. In fact, the legs are made of solid European oak or black oak, with a steel core: a product with high-quality technology and craftsmanship.

materials:

structure in aluminum anthracite grey lacquer. finish of legs/top: grey cement.

In 2011, Kristalia embarked on a new challenge launched by the designers LucidiPevere: to design a cement table. In 2013, the table called Boiacca is a new challenge: to switch from the material quality of cement to the natural quality of wood. The table called Boiacca Wood has legs in solid European oak wood, internally reinforced with a steel core. The top is available in Pure-white laminate or black Fenix-NTM® with a soft-touch effect. It has a black or white epoxy lacquered aluminium frame just like the top. This new challenge for Kristalia, in partnership with the designer duo LucidiPevere, has led to the creation of an elegant and minimalist object.


