Offcut, a set of chunky, waney edge oak or birch components gives the owner the satisfaction of constructing their own stool or table by hammering the joins together with wooden dowels to make a solid, long lasting piece of furniture. Offcut challenges the perception of flat-pack as cheap and disposable. It can be easily stacked and stored.
